

# Bloom's Taxonomy for Catechesis

## *Stages of Learning*

**Learning Strand** (Sacraments, Prayer, Moralilty, Parables)

<b>Stage</b>	<b>Strategy</b>
<p><b>Remembering:</b> <i>Knowledge.</i> Recall or retrieve previous learned information. Recite a definition or list. Quote scripture. Knows the process.</p>	
<p><b>Understanding:</b> <i>Comprehension.</i> Understand the principle. Explain in one's own words the steps involved. Can provide examples.</p>	
<p><b>Applying:</b> <i>Application.</i> Can apply concept to a new situation. Can understand or predict outcomes.</p>	
<p><b>Analyzing:</b> <i>Analysis.</i> Identify parts so that its organizational structure may be understood. Distinguishes between facts and inferences.</p>	
<p><b>Evaluating:</b> <i>Evaluation.</i> Make personal judgments about the value of ideas or materials. Select the most effective solution. Discriminate between variables. Explain and justify a new situation.</p>	
<p><b>Creating:</b> <i>Synthesis.</i> Builds a structure or pattern. Put parts together to form a whole, with emphasis on creating a new meaning or structure.</p>
