Recite a definition or list. Quote scripture. Knows the process. **Understanding**: Comprehension. Understand the principle. Explain in one's own words the steps involved. Can provide examples. **Applying**: *Application*. Can apply concept to a new situation. Can understand or predict outcomes. **Analyzing**: *Analysis*. Identify parts so that its organizational structure may be understood. Distinguishes between facts and inferences. **Evaluating**: *Evaluation*. Make personal judgments about the value of ideas or materials. Select the most effective solution. Discriminate between variables. Explain and justify a new situation. Creating: Synthesis. Builds a structure or pattern. Put parts together to form a whole, with emphasis on creating a new meaning or structure.
