

# Flipped Classrooms for Catechesis

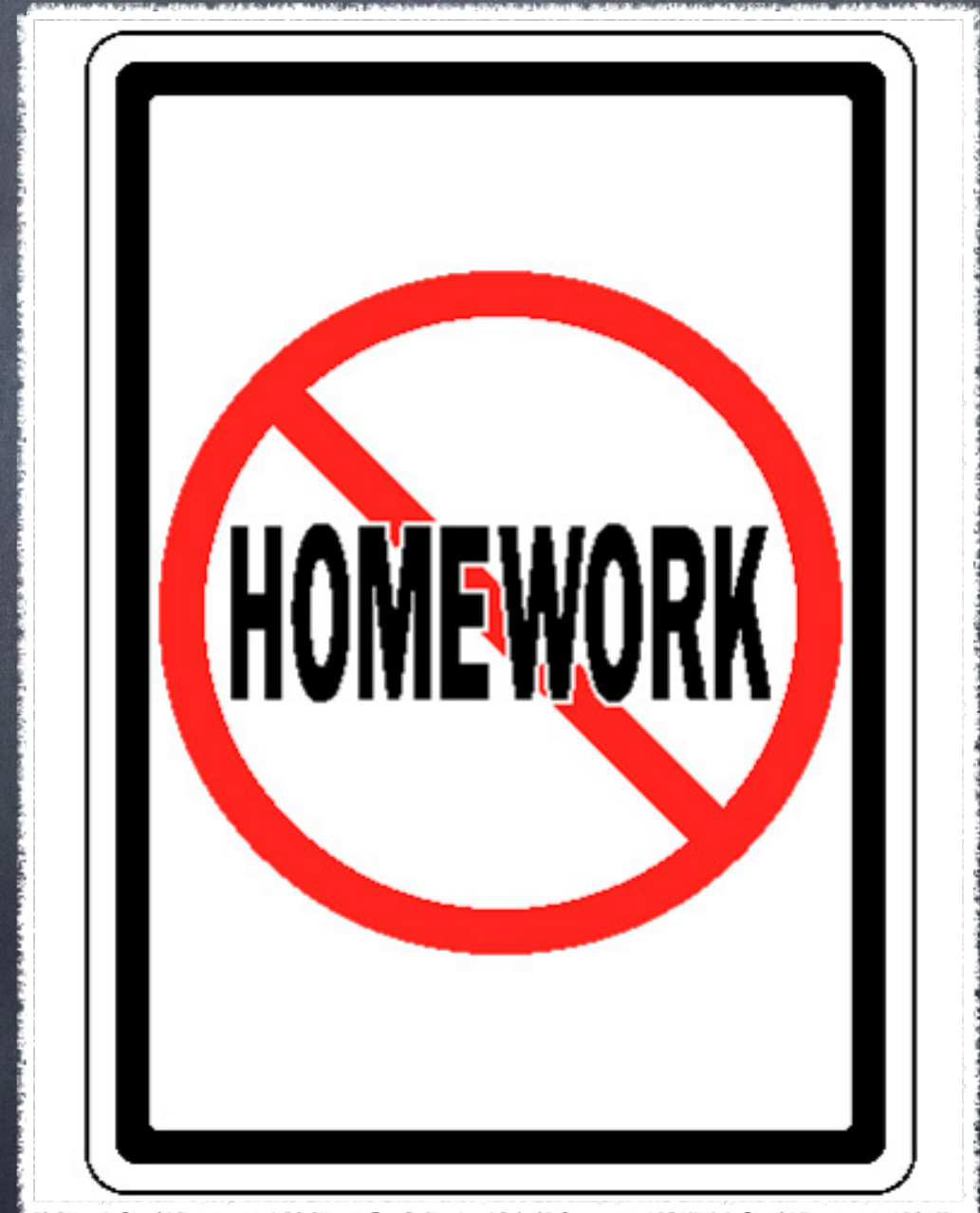

# the problem

- most children/families will not do homework we send after class
- most do not think of content during the week
- 75 minutes is too short





# the solution?

- flip it around
- give them a fun but meaningful reason to do it at home
- make more use of time during class





# how do I flip my class?

- use or create video
- encourage reflection
- motivate response



# a note about videos

- use existing videos
- create student videos
- create a photo collage with voice-over
- create a lecture/intro





# a note about reflection

- provoke thought
- may be a statement, questions, multiple choice
- no need to worry about correct answers or grading
- could refer to the eBook
- ask for an short written response





# a note about responses

- sets expectation
- gets them thinking
- insures participation
- use responses to stimulate discussion

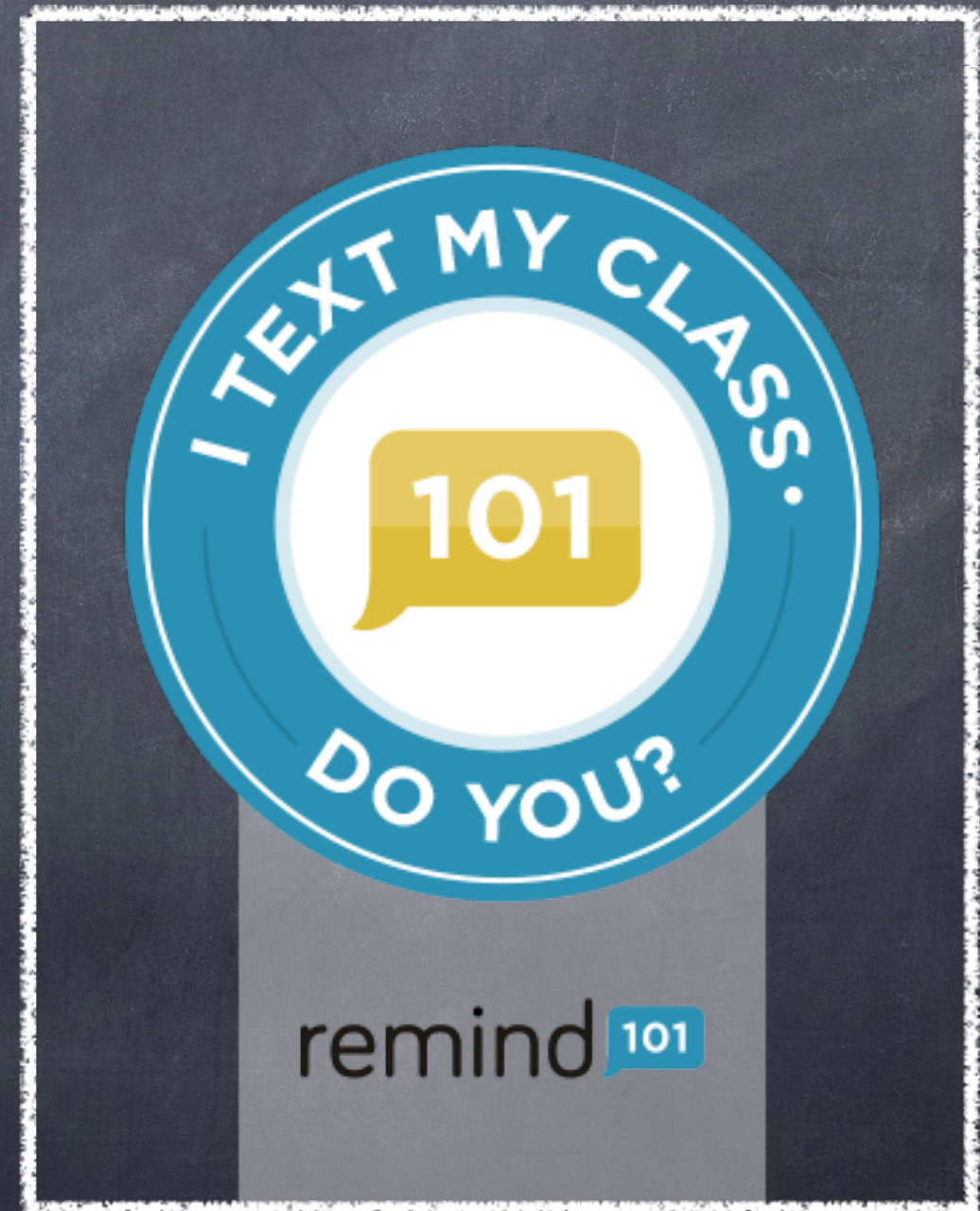
# Let's try!
