






In your program, do you feel parents receive important information on a timely basis in the most effective way?




If your ministry has an open channel for feedback, how effective is it?




Outside of session time, have you been able to connect members of small groups such as Bible Study, Youth Ministry, or even parents of a grade level class?




Have you ever said, "I have a difficult time getting the parents to do anything with their kids at home?"




What percent of parents think that the church should be the primary educator of faith for their children?

Flip the Switch: Reinforce At-Home Activities

Benefits

- Weekly communication
- Reminder
- Activate prior knowledge
- Allow processing time
- Gives parents at home something to do that doesn't take long
- Solicit feedback
- Just in Time Teaching (JiTT)

Flip the Switch: Reinforce At-Home Activities

- Elementary (not necessarily using texting)
 - Send home textbook features before lesson
 - Family created prayer list
 - Send home liturgical seasons activities and display at church
 - Create at-home pocket prayer books
 - At home nature walk & bring back items
 - Have families find a song that has meaning or a message of faith to share in class

Flip the Switch: Reinforce Home Activities



- Adolescent
 - Send form for weekly class, bible studies, etc.
 - Use for retreats or other large and less-frequent functions
 - Statistics from surveys and polls are interesting to everyone. Get info from flip and use during session. (JiTT)
 - Consider creating longer teaching videos (when comfortable with the process)





Adult

- Sending relevant children's activities home to align with Adult Ed topics to promote learning
- After session, post 3 questions to an online discussion board and invite attendees to respond
- Utilize flipping with small faith groups. Solicit questions to be addressed at the next session
- Break pre-recorded video sessions into short segments. Develop a few questions for each segment and begin your own online class
- Record your own session introductions




